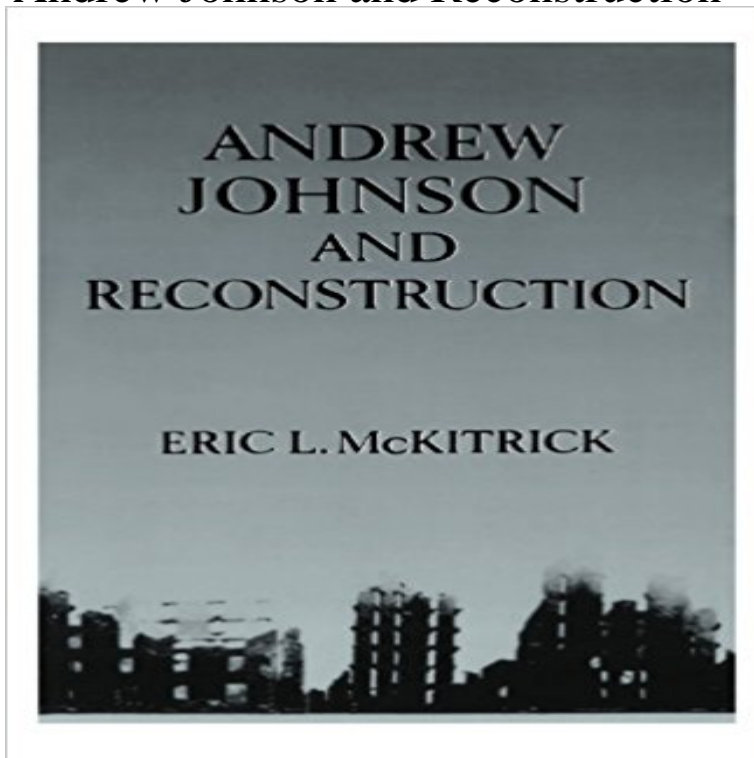


Andrew Johnson and Reconstruction
