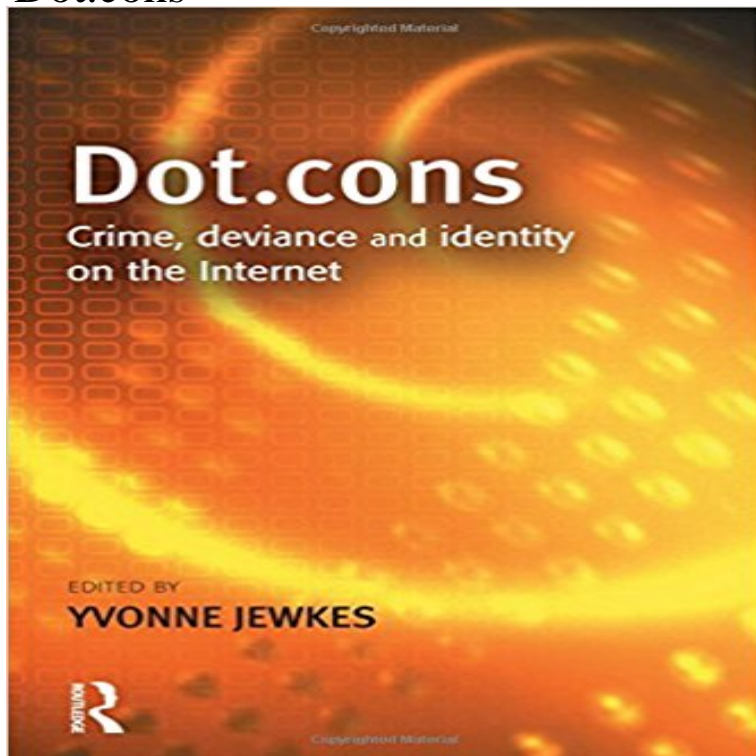


Dot.cons
