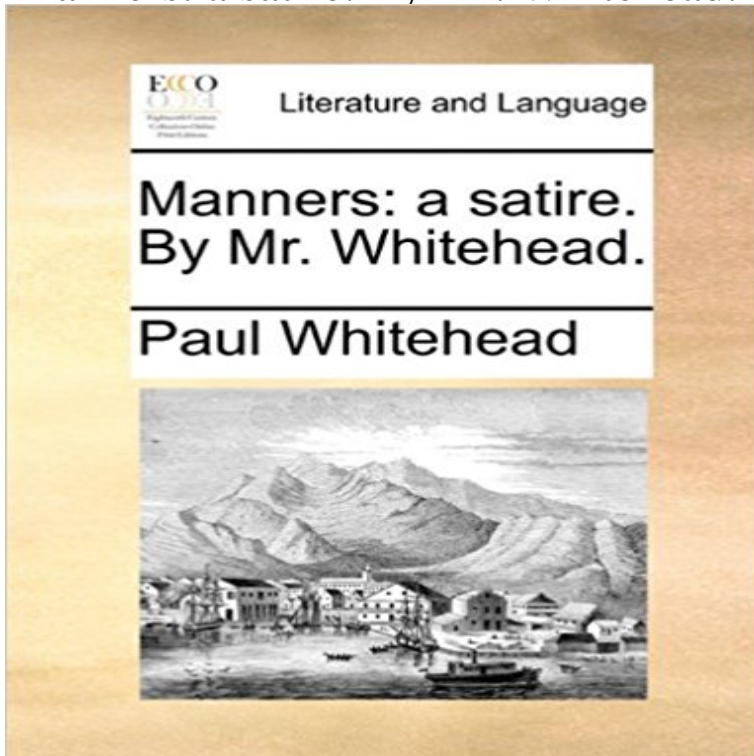


Manners: a satire. By Mr. Whitehead.
