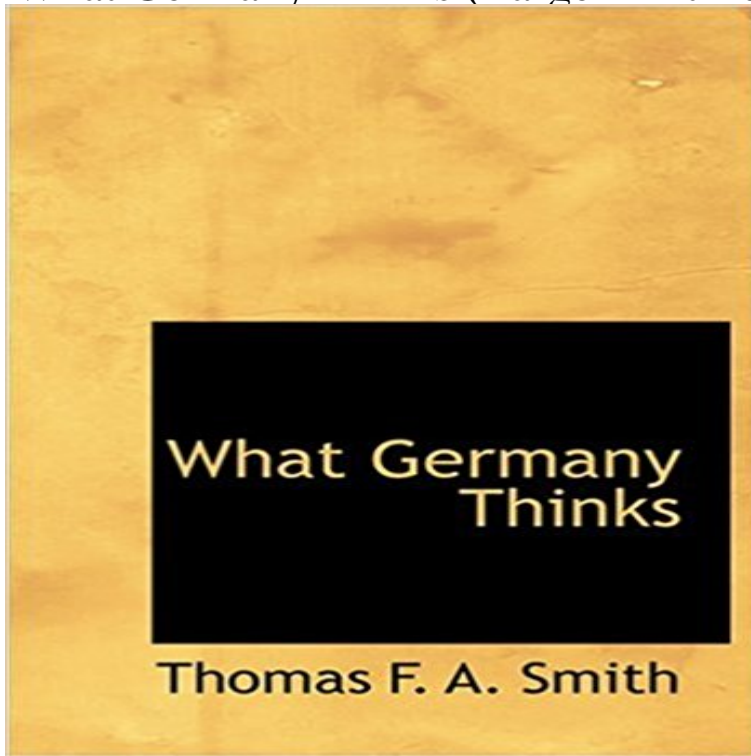


What Germany Thinks (Large Print Edition)
