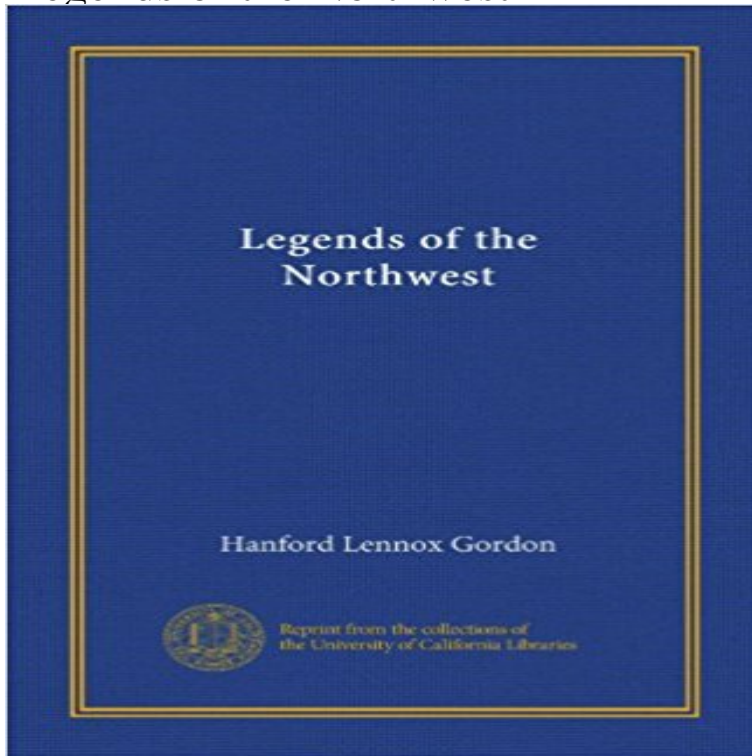


Legends of the Northwest
