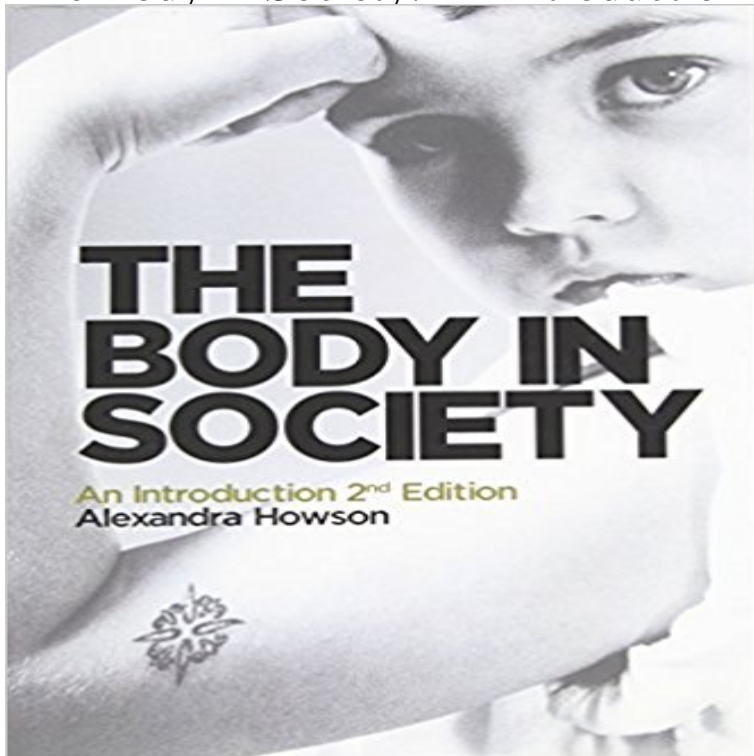


The Body in Society: An Introduction
