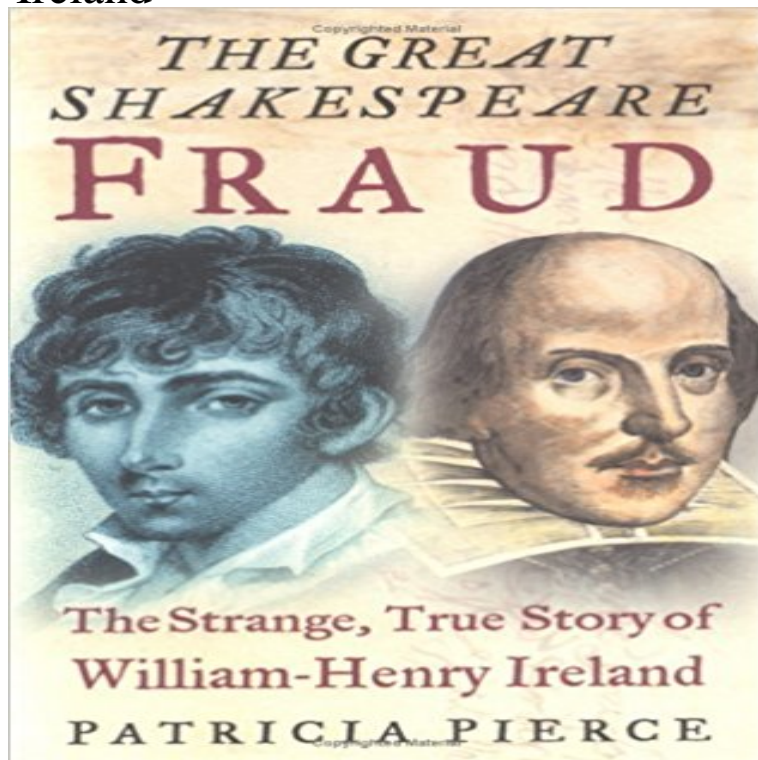


The Great Shakespeare Fraud: The Strange, True Story of William-Henry Ireland

Beginning with a deed signed by Shakespeare, William-Henry followed this with a rapid succession of poems, letters and even an entirely new play, Vortigern. His success was phenomenal. James Boswell knelt to kiss the relics of Shakespeare, eminent clergyman Dr. Joseph Warton proclaimed Shakespeares Profession of Faith to be better than anything in either the church service or the litany, and Sheridan agreed to stage Vortigern. Yet the play marked the beginning of the end for the great Shakespeare forger. Staged two days after the expert Edmond Malone irrefutably exposed the forgeries, the esteemed actors were greeted with hoots of derision during Vortigerns single performance.
