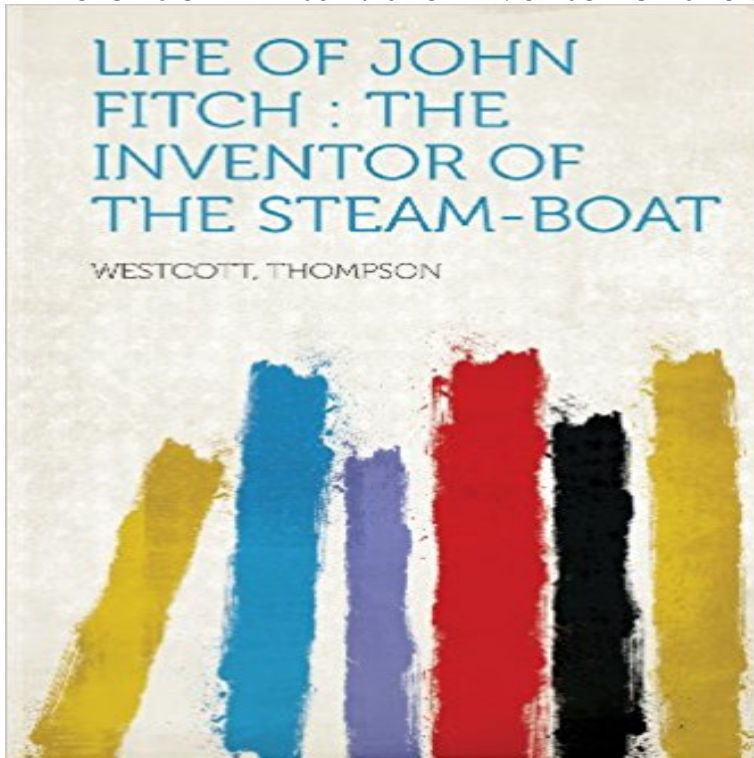


Life of John Fitch: the Inventor of the Steam-Boat
